- D. Stem (Qal, etc.)
- E. Tense (Perfect, etc.)
- F. Verbal Root (e.g. ヿコ゚゚)
- G. Meaning of the Verbal Root (e.g. "to remember")
- V. Two Consonants Alike in a Row with a Silent Shewa under the First Consonant

When there are two consonants alike in a row, and the first consonant has a silent shewa under it, the first consonant assimilates into the second consonant doubling it, and the stlent shewa that was under the first consonant drops out (e.g. 110) ψ - 110 ψ - "we dwelt").
