

D. State of the Dual Ending

The dual ending is always in the absolute state. It has no construct state. Therefore, if a word which would normally take a dual ending is used in the construct state, it takes a regular plural construct ending (e.g. 'י'י' - "eyes of").

NOTE: The dual ending should not be confused with the plural ending on such words as "water" (מַיִם) and "heavens" (שָׁמַיִם).
