- 3. The uses of the tongue 9-12.
 - a. Proper use v. 9a
 It is used as an instrument to praise God for His power and love.
 - b. Improper use v.9b-12. It is used as an instrument to invoke evil on man who is made in the image of God.

Note: These two uses of the tongue are inconsistent and since the inconsistency is impossible in all the rest of God's creation, it is also impossible in the highest of God's creation which is man. Therefore, if the tongue is used as an instrument to invoke evil on man, it cannot be used as an instrument to praise God. Thus, if any praise comes forth from it, that praise is phony. vs. 10-12.
