keep that godly going so that the Messiah will come and so that you and I will have a redeemer.

- 4. History of Noah (6:9-9:29)
 - i. Preparation for the flood (6:9-22)
 - a. Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord because he was a righteous man who walked with the Lord (i. had fellowship with God).
 - b. He had three sons who are married:
 - 1) Shem
 - 2) Ham
 - 3) Japheth
 - c. The Lord says he is going to destroy the earth with a flood
 - He is going to wipe all the animals, creeping things, birds and people are going to be wiped out, except Noah and he family.
 - 2) He wants Noah to make an ark
 - i) It is to be made of cypress wood and coated with pitch inside and out.
 - ii) It is to be 450 ft. long, 75 ft. wide and 45 ft. high.
 - iii) He wants rooms in that ark.
 - iv) There are to be three different levels
 - a) Lower deck
 - b) Middle deck
 - c) Upper deck
 - There is to be a covering over the ark and a door in the side of the ark.
 - vi) Noah wants him to take animals, birds, and creeping things.
 - a) He is to put two of each, male and female, for the purpose of reproduction after the flood.
 - b) He wants seven of the clean animals. Probably, they would be three pairs of male and female and one male so they could be used for sacrifice. The same thing was to be true for the clean birds.
 - vii) Noah is to put food for the animals and people on board.
 - 3) Noah obeyed the command of the Lord.
 - i) Noah was probably the target of ridicule.
 - ii) But he obeyed God and warned people of the fold.
