- 3) Genesis 47:9
 - i) Jacob is talking to Pharaoh and says, "The days of the years of my pilgrimage are an hundred and thirty years."
 - ii) Jacob is 130 years old when he comes to Egypt.
 - iii) 1879 + 130 = 2009 B. C. as date of Jacob's birth
- 4) Genesis 25:26
 - i) "And after that came his brother out, and his hand took hold on Esau's heel; and his name was called Jacob: and Isaac was threescore years old when she bare them."
 - ii) 2009 + 60 = 2069 B. C. as date of Isaac's birth
- 5) Genesis 21:5
 - i) "And Abraham was an hundred years old, when his son Isaac was born unto him."
 - ii) 2069 + 100 = 2169 B. C. as date of birth of Abraham
- Genesis 12:4
 - i) Abram is 75 when he left Haran.
 - ii) 2169 75 = 2094 B. C. as the date of Abraham's call.
- iii. Career (12:4-25:11)
 - a. Removal to Canaan (12:4-9)
 - 1) Abram leaves Haran and goes to Shechem.
 - i) When he gets there, the Lord makes a promise to him: "To your offspring I will give this land"
 - ii) Abram builds an alter and worships and thanks the Lord.
 - 2) He leaves Shechem and goes to Bethel
 - i) There he builds an alter to the Lord and worships the Lord.
 - ii) He leaves there with Sarai and Lot with him.
 - 3) He goes down to the south (the Negev)
 - b. Journey to Egypt (12:10-20)
 - 1) He encounters a famine in the Negev.
 - 2) He knows that there is food in Egypt and so he goes down to Egypt
