- 10) But then the Lord says, "Because Ishmael is your son, I am going to make a great nation and 12 rulers will come through him."
- 11) When the Lord finishes speaking to Abraham, Abraham obeys the Lord (this is one of the characteristics of Abraham) and has everyone circumcised.
- h. Divine visitors (18)
 - 1) Abraham is at Mamre.
 - Three visitors come to Abraham.
 - i) The Lord in human form
 - ii) Two angels in human form
 - 3) He gives them water to wash their feet and has a meal prepared to refresh them.
 - 4) Sarah is in the tent.
 - 5) The Lord speaks to him and says, "At this time next year I am going to visit you and you are going to have a son."
 - i) The Lord spoke these words for Sarah's benefit.
 - Sarah responds with laughter of unbelief when she hears these words.
 - 6) The Lord asks, "Why did Sarah laugh? Is anything impossible with God? I will visit you next year at this time and you will have a son."
 - 7) Sarah comes out of the tent and she says, "I didn't laugh."
 - 8) But the Lord said, "Yes you did."
 - The Lord said this to establish her faith.
 - 10)The three visitors leave Mamre
 - i) They start down toward Sodom and Abraham goes with them.
 - ii) The Lord speaks to Abraham, "I've heard a tremendous outcry from Sodom, an outcry for punishment for all their sin and I am going down there to see if what they are doing warrants that outcry."
 - iii) Abraham knew it would and knew that the Lord was going to punish Sodom and Gomorrah and that's why he interceded for Sodom.
 - iv) There was a reason why Abraham interceded for Sodom: Because Lot and his family were there.
 - v) Abraham said to the Lord, "Now you won't destroy the righteous with the wicked"
 - a) We are told in the Word of God that Lot was a righteous man.
 - vi) He says, "Won't the Judge of all the earth do right?"
