- 14) When they got there, the Lord rained down burning sulfur upon Sodom and Gomorrah (it is not under the Dead Sea).
- 15) Abraham got up the next morning and saw the smoke ascending from Sodom and Gomorrah.
- 16)Gen 19:29 God remembered Abraham and sent Lot out of the catastrophe that overthrew the city.
 - i) The Lord knew what Abraham wanted.
 - ii) The Lord granted that request.
- 17) Lot takes his two daughters and goes into the mountains.
 - i) There is no body there to carry on Lot's line.
 - ii) They got their daddy drunk and had sexual relationships with him to cause their father's line to continue:
 - iii) The sons born
 - a) by the oldest Moab from whom came the Moabites
 - b) by the youngest Ammon from whom came the Ammonites
 - iv) The Moabites and the Ammonites were going to give Israel trouble throughout their history.
- j. Events at Gerar (20)
 - Abraham leaves Mamre and goes into the south country, in the Negev, probably to find better pasture.
 - 2) While he is in the south country, he goes to Gerar and is concerned about his safety.
 - i) He is concerned about his safety because of Sarah.
 - ii) He thinks that because Sarah is so beautiful, the people of Gerar are going to kill him to get her.
 - iii) So he tells Sarah to tell them that she is his sister.
 - iv) Abraham does the same thing again and doesn't learn his lesson.
 - 3) Abimelech takes Sarah to be his wife, but the Lord intervenes before she is dishonored.
 - i) The Lord caused Abimelech to have a dream and in this dream, he says, "Abimelech, you are a dead man and the reason you are a dead man is because the woman you have taken is married."
 - ii) Abimelech says he didn't know that and he was innocent.
