- I. Offering of Isaac (22)
 - Abraham is still in Beersheba and Isaac has grown up into a young man.
 - 2) The Lord is going to test Abraham's faith.
 - 3) The Lord comes to Abraham and says, "I want you to take Isaac and offer him up as a burnt offering to me. Go to the region of Moriah (the area around Jerusalem) to the mountain I will show you."
 - 4) If Isaac is offered up as a burnt offering, what happens to the fulfillment of all those promises?
 - 5) Abraham obeyed the Lord immediately.
 - 6) He takes the donkey, two of his servants and Isaac.
 - 7) On the 3rd day, Abraham spots the mountain where the Lord told him to offer his son. **C
 - 8) He tells his servant (22:5), "Stay here with the donkey while I and the boy go over there. We will worship and then we will come back to you."
 - 9) Abraham takes the boy, goes to the mountain, build the alter, put the wood on the altar, binds his son, and put him on the altar.
 - 10)He took the knife in his hand, lifted his hand and was about to kill him.
 - 11)Why did Abraham go through (with it? Hebrews says that he believed that if he obeyed God, God would keep his promise and raise Isaac from the dead.
 - 12) This was a test of Abraham's faith. Did he really believe that God would keep his promise? He did.
 - 13)The Lord called out to him and told him not to kill his son because He knew that Abraham really feared him.
 - 14) The Lord tells him, "I swear by myself that because you have done this and have not withheld your soon, I will surely bless you and make your descendants as numerous as the stars of the sky and sand of the sea shore. Your descendants will take possession of the cities of their enemies."
 - 15) Abraham's obedience is the outworking of Abraham's saving faith. Faith and good works are inseparable. True, saving faith produces good works. Without it, that faith is as dead as a doornail.
- m. Death of Sarah (23)
 - 1) When Abraham gets back to Mamre, Sarah dies.
 - 2) She lives to 127 years of age.
 - 3) Sarah is the only woman whose age is given in the Bible.
