

- c) Moses said, "Now listen. The Lord has told us to go on that three day journey to worship him. Now we don't know what kind of animals he is going to want us to use till we get them and we don't know how many he wants us to use, so we take them all."
- d) So Pharaoh refuses to let the people of Israel go.

7) Exodus 11

- i) So the Lord speaks to Moses, "I am going to bring one more plague upon Pharaoh. I want you to go to Pharaoh and I want you to give him a message. After this plague, he is going to let the people of Israel go."
- ii) 10th plague - death of the firstborn *son and animal*
- iii) Moses goes to Pharaoh and gives him the message.
 - a) We have part of the message here.
 - b) And part of it was told to him before.
- iv) The message would go something like this:
 - a) "Israel is Jehovah's firstborn. You wouldn't let Israel go. Now ^{Chapter 11 is spoken before} what the Lord is going to do is take all of your male firstborn. He is going to start with your firstborn son and take every other firstborn son right down to the first born son of a slave girl working ^{10:28} ~~whose~~ grinding at the mill. But not only is every firstborn son going to be taken, but also will the firstborn male of every animal. And when this happens, there is going to be weeping in Egypt like never before."
 - Exodus 11:1 is translated as "And the LORD said to Moses"*
 - b) "And when this happens, your officials are going to come to me and they are going to order us out of Egypt."
- v) When Pharaoh heard this message, he was angry and said, "You get out of here. If I see your face again, you will die."
 - a) Now when you read that account, it sounds like those words were spoken before.
 - b) But if you read carefully those words had been spoken prior to that event.
- vi) Moses left and was angry with Pharaoh, but the Lord told Moses, "I am going to harden Pharaoh's heart and he is not going to let the children of Israel go."
