

- d. He is going to give them a diet.
 - 1) He goes over all the animals in the four classes:
 - i) Four legged animals
 - ii) Animals in the sea
 - iii) Animals that fly in the air
 - iv) The animals that creep on the ground
 - 2) He shows them which of those animals are clean and which are not clean.
 - 3) He says, "You only eat the ones that are clean and when you come to me make sure that you have only been eating that which is clean. If you eat that which is unclean and you come into my sanctuary, guess what is going to happen? You are going to breathe your last breath."
- ii. Childbirth (12)
 - a. Here's a mother who has a little boy.
 - 1) When she has that little boy, she is unclean for 7 days.
 - 2) After that, she has to undergo 33 days of purification so that she there is no uncleanness about her whatsoever.
 - 3) After 40 days, she comes to the tabernacle to offer the sin offering and the burnt offering.
 - b. Suppose the mother has a girl.
 - 1) The mother has two weeks of uncleanness.
 - 2) She has to be purified for 66 days.
 - 3) After 80 days, she has to offer the sin offering and burnt offering to the Lord at the tabernacle.
 - c. 12:4
 - 1) "She must not touch anything sacred or go to the sanctuary until the days of her purification are over."
 - 2) The Lord is going to make it very clear that if anybody does, they are dead.
 - d. So when you approach the Lord, you do it on his terms. You do it the way he says because if you don't you are rebelling against His laws. He's made it possible for you and me to approach him.
 - e. "If you do it my way, you'll have fellowship with me. But if you don't," the Lord says, "I am going to show myself holy and judgment is going to come." And of course they learned that in the case of Nadab and Abihu.
