- f. How were they supposed to live during this time?
 - 1) What was the Lord going to do?
 - The Lord was going to give them so much on the 48th year that it will carry them for three years.
- g. On the year of jubilee, the following would happen
 - If a person had sold himself to work as a servant because he couldn't make ends meet, the person would be free and allowed to go back to his own family.
 - 2) The land was returned.
 - i) So if you had land and things were getting tough and you sold your land because you couldn't make it, you would actually sell your crops that would be harvested and the person who bought it would keep it until the year of jubilee.
 - ii) On the year of jubilee you get your land back.
 - iii) The land is returned to the original owner so he can start all over again.
 - iv) Would that be unfair to the person who bought it?
 - a) No.
 - b) When you sell your land, you count how many years since the last jubilee and how many years to the next jubilee. Now you figure out how many harvests from now to the next jubilee. And you sell those harvests to that person. So that person will get his money's worth.
 - 3) He says, "If you want to walk with me. You treat that land the way I tell you to or the fellowship with me will be broken.
- 6. Covenantal promises/warnings (26)
 - The Lord makes it clear that he wants his people to obey him.
 - ii. He says, "Now look here's your choice. You can obey me and have great blessing. If you obey me, here's what is going to happen.
 - a. That ground is really going to yield crops. By the time next year's crops come, you are going to have to move what you have left over from last year. You are going to have an abundance of crops.
 - b. Those olive trees are really going to produce olives and you are going to have all the oil you want.
 - c. Those grape vines are going to produce grapes. And I am going to protect you.
 - 1) You aren't going to have wild animals going through your land and killing you and your kids.
 - 2) You aren't going to have foreign armies going through your land.
