    - 1) Made up of
      - i) Reuben as the leader
        - a) Reuben's banner might have had the head of a man.
      - ii) Simeon and Gad
  - g. The third division to the west
    - 1) Made up of
      - i) Ephraim as the leader
        - a) Ephraim's banner may have had an ox on it.
      - ii) Manasseh and Benjamin
    - 2) All of these are the sons of Rachel
  - h. The fourth division to the north
    - 1) Made up of
      - i) Dan as the leader
        - a) Dan's banner may have had an eagle.
      - ii) Asher and Naphtali
  - i. All of these divisions are at a distance from the tabernacle.
- ii. Chapter 3
- a. The Lord says, "Moses, I want you to count all the male Levites from a month old and up. Get the number."
  - b. They had 22,000 Levites.
  - c. These Levites are going to be divided up into three groups around the tabernacle.
  - d. Levi had three sons.
    - 1) Kohath
    - 2) Gershon
    - 3) Merari
  - e. The descendants of those three sons are to make up the three groups into which the Levites are to be divided.
