- 4. He also tells how the three cities of refuge were set up on the eastern side of the Jordan River
 - i. Bezer city of refuge in the south in Reuben's territory
 - ii. Ramoth Gilead city of refuge in the central part Gad's territory
 - iii. Golan city of refuge in the north in the half tribe of Manasseh
 - iv. It is set up this way so that people can get to them very easily

C. Stipulations (5-26)

- 1. General stipulations (5-11)
 - These are not detailed laws.
 - ii. In chapter 5, Moses reiterates the 10 commandments to the children of Israel.
 - iii. He tells them that they are not only to obey the 10 commandments, but they are to openly all the other laws that God gave on Mt. Sinai.
 - iv. They are not only obey these laws, but they are to teach them to their children (6:6-7).
 - a. They are to impress the laws on the hearts of their children.
 - b. They are to impress them when they get up, when they sit down and when they walk with them.
 - c. They are to do this not just so that they will know the laws, but so that they will obey the laws.
 - v. Then, in chapter 7, he says, "When you get into the land, I want you to utterly destroy the Canaanites who are there."
 - a. Remember that the Lord told Abraham, "I can't give you this land for 400 years."
 - b. The Lord was going to give these people a chance to repent.
 - c. They wouldn't repent and now judgment is going to come.
 - d. The Israelites are going to be the Lord's instrument to bring that judgment.
 - e. 7:17
 - 1) Moses says to them, "You may say to yourselves, These nations are stronger than we are. How can we drive them out?"
 - 2) Moses says, "If you get somebody who talks like that, you advise them of a simple fact. You advise them of what the Lord did to the Egyptian army. He drowned them all in the Red Sea. And the Egyptian army was a lot more powerful than these other nations. And that's what the Lord will do to these people."

 He says, "Now when the Lord destroys them, he is not going to destroy them all at once. If he destroyed them all at once, then the
