- vi. All of the sudden, the night lights up with light.
- vii. Then they hear, "The sword of the Lord and of Gideon."
- viii. And they go crazy and turn on one another and kill one another and start to flee.
- 16. Gideon contacts the armies of Naphtali and Asher and Manasseh and tells them to go after the Midianite soldiers.
  - i. They do and they kill 120,000.
- 17. Gideon and his 300 men pursue Zeeb and Oreb, the two kings of the Midianites and they cross over the Jordan past Succoth and Peniel and capture the two Midianites.
- 18. Because the two kings were responsible for the death of Gideon's brother, Gideon kills all of them and he delivers Israel from the Midianites.
- 19. After 7 years of intense oppression, the Israelites are delivered.
- 20. Gideon judged Israel for 40 years.

## H. Tola and Jair (9:1-10:5) - unknown

- 1. Tola
  - We are not told anything about Tola except that he judged Israel for 23 years.
  - ii. But according to chapter 2, it would be the same old story of relapse into idolatry, retribution from God, repentance and then rescue.
- 2. Jair
  - i. Jair is raised up and judges for 22 years.

## I. Jephthah (10:6-12:7) - Ammon

- 1. At this time, Israel relapses into idolatry again.
- The Lord brings divine retribution and this time it is over on the eastern side of the Jordan River.
  - i. The Ammonites come and oppress Israel for 18 years.
- 3. Israel repents and then the Lord raises up a deliverer in the person of Jephthah. who judget That for E years
- 4. Here's what happens:
  - The Ammonites decided that they wanted to take back the land that once belonged to them and Israel conquered.
  - ii. The land went from the brook Arnon to the brook Jabbok.
  - iii. All of the land once belonged to the Ammonites.
  - iv. But Sihon, king of the Ammorites, took it from them.
