

- v. Samuel confronts Saul and says, "The Lord said you should go down and destroy the Amalekites."
 - vi. Saul said, "I did."
 - vii. Samuel said, "If you have destroyed everything, why are these sheep here?"
 - viii. He said, "Well I brought them back to sacrifice to the Lord."
 - ix. Then Samuel said, "Which is better? To obey the Lord or to sacrifice? Because you have done this, you are rejected as being king of Israel."
 - a. First his kingdom was rejected so it wouldn't go on after him.
 - b. Now he is rejected as king.
 - x. After Samuel said that, "You know it really wasn't my fault. The men put pressure on me to bring these animals back. I was afraid of them and I gave in. Samuel please forgive me and come back and honor me with your presence. At least do that so the people won't know that the Lord has rejected me as king."
 - xi. Samuel says, "No I am not going back" and he started to leave.
 - xii. Saul reaches out and grabs party of Samuel's garments and it tore off.
 - xiii. Samuel looks Saul straight in the eye and says, "See the way you tore that garment off of me. That is the way the kingdom is going to be torn from you."
 - xiv. Saul then says, "Well, please come back."
 - xv. Samuel did go back and the reason he went back was to keep order until the Lord would remove Saul from the throne and to finish carrying out what the Lord had commanded because Agag was still alive.
 - xvi. Samuel killed Agag himself.
28. When Saul is rejected as king, the Lord tells Samuel to go to Bethlehem and anoint one of the sons of Jesse to be king.
- i. That son was David who was from the line of Judah.
 - ii. Samuel anoints David, but Saul doesn't know it.
29. The Lord prepares David to be the king.
- i. When David is anointed to be king, the Spirit of the Lord that was then upon Saul leaves him and comes on David.
 - ii. An evil spirit then came on Saul and troubled him.
 - iii. One of his servants said, "King Saul, why don't you do this? When that evil spirit troubles you, get somebody to play the harp to make you feel better."
 - iv. Then one of his servants said, "I know somebody, the son of Jesse."
