

- iv. Then Saul tells Jonathan to kill David.
 - a. David says, "Why do you want to kill David? Look at all these battles he's won for you."
 - b. And Saul swears that he wouldn't kill him, but that didn't last long.
 - v. Saul's jealousy resumes and he wants to rub David out.
 - a. He again tries to get him with the javelin.
 - b. That fails.
 - vi. David goes to his home and Michal his wife says, "Dad sent down guards and they are going to kill you in the morning. You had better get out of the house."
 - vii. So she lets him out of the window.
33. He comes back to Gibeah and he tells Jonathan, "your Dad is trying to kill me."
34. Jonathan said, "No. dad swore that he wouldn't take your life."
35. David said, "Look there is one way I can prove it. I am supposed to dine with your father at the new moon festival. Now I am going to be absent. What I want you to do is this. I want you to tell your dad that you gave me permission to go to Bethlehem and offer sacrifices. And if he gets angry, you'll know that he is trying to kill me. But if he says, "Well that's alright," you'll know he is not."
36. So Jonathan goes to the feast.
- i. On the 2nd day of the feast, Saul says, "Where's David?"
 - ii. When Jonathan said he gave him permission to go to Bethlehem, then he called him the son of a perverse woman.
 - iii. Then Saul said, "How could you take his side."
 - iv. And he even tried to kill his own son Jonathan.
 - v. Then Jonathan said, "David you'd better get out of here. You are right. He's trying to kill you."
37. So David goes to Nob.
- i. The tabernacle had been moved from Shiloh to Nob in the time of Saul.
 - ii. David goes to Nob and is on the run and needs food.
 - iii. Abimelech the high priest gave some bread that had been on the table of shewbread to eat and he gave him Goliath's sword.
38. Then David goes from Nob over to Gath.
- i. The men at Gath recognize him as David.
 - ii. David acted like a madman to escape them.
