Dogs are going to devour your wife, Jezebel."

When Ahab heard that, he humbled himself before the Lord.

- i) The Lord said that because Ahab humbled himself before the Lord, the thing \\$\text{he said would happen still would happen, but not in his lifetime."
- ii) Then we are told that Ahab went to battle to try to reclaim Ramoth Gilead.
 - a) When he did this, he was killed.
 - b) He was killed in his chariot and his blood flowed down the chariot floor.
 - c) When the chariot got back to Samaria, the dogs came at the very spot where Naboth was killed and licked Ahab's blood out of his chariot.

iii. Ahaziah

- The son of Ahab.
- b. He reigned for only 2 years.
- c. He was in Samaria one day and fell through a lattice in the palace roof and he died as a result of it.
- d. When he died, since he had no son, his brother, another son of Absalom became king.
 - e. That brother's name is Jehoram.

iv. Jehoram

- a. He was king for 12 years.
- While he was king, he went over to defend Ramoth Gilead which was within the hands of Israel again.
- c. While he was here, he was wounded.
- d. When he was wounded, he went to Jezreel to recover.
- e. At this point, another man comes on the scene by the name of Jehu.
 - Jehu was a commander of Israel's army.
 - 2) He was here at Ramoth Gilead.
 - Elisha became the prophet after Elijah.
 - 4) Elisha tells a prophet, "I want you to go to Jehu at Ramoth Gilead and I want you to anoint Jehu to be the king. Tell him to cut off all of the descendants of Ahab and tell Jehu that Jezebel will be devoured by dogs at the wall of Jezreel."
 - 5) The prophet gives Jehu the message and anoints him as king.
 - 6) The soldier with Jehu proclaim him as king.
