- a. The son of Jehu
- b. When he was king, Hazael oppressed Israel.
 - 1) He almost completely destroyed the army of Jehoahaz.
 - He took a lot of territory from them.
 - 3) It became so severe that the Lord decided that he was going to deliver Israel from Hazael.

c. Jehoash

- 1) The son of Jehoahaz
- He reigned for 16 years.
- 3) When he became king, Elisha was still alive.
- 4) Elisha made a prediction to Jehoash.
 - i) He said, "The Lord is going to give you three victories over the richary our Bos - hodad, son of HE wat Syrians."
 - ii) The Lord did that.
 - iii) The Syrians were defeated and the towns taken by Hazael from Israel were restored under Jehoash.

d. Jeroboam 2

- 1) The son of Jehoash
- He is the 3rd generation from Jehu.
- He reigns for 41 years.

3. The kings of Judah

i. Joash

- a. He was king for 40 years.
- b. Hazael came down and was all set to attack Jerusalem.
- c. Joash said to Hazael, "Look I'll pay you whatever you want if you don't attack."
- d. So Joash paid him gold and silver and became subject to Syria.
- e. Hazael died right at the time that Jehoahaz died and it was his successor, his son Ben-Hadad, that Jehoash defeated and regained the towns that Hazael had taken from Israel.

ii. Amaziah

- a. The son of Joash
- b. He reigned for 29 years.
