## H. 7th period: Foreign Domination (686-636 B. C.)

- Manasseh
  - i. The son of Hezekiah
  - ii. He reigns for 55 years.
  - iii. He was more wicked the people in Canaan before the Israelites conquered the land.
- 2. Amon
  - i. The son of Manasseh
  - ii. He reigned for 2 years and was assassinated
- 3. Assyria is growing stronger
  - i. They have conquered the northern kingdom.
  - ii. They have conquered part of Judah.
  - iii. Judah is subject to Assyria.
- 4. During this time, Assyria reaches its zenith.
  - The Lord sent the prophet Nahum.
  - ii. Nahum predicted that Assyria was going to be destroyed.
  - iii. 612 B. C. is when Ninevah was destroyed.
- 5. When he talks about foreign domination, he is talking about Assyria dominating Judah.

## I. 8th period: Fall of Judah (636-586 B. C.)

- 1. Josiah
  - i. He was a good king.
  - ii. He was only 7 years old when he became king.
  - iii. He reigned for 31 years.
  - iv. In the first 17 years of his reign, there was no reformation.
- v. It was during this time of the first 17 years that the prophet Zepheniah acme on the scene.
  - vi. He was a preacher of judgment.
    - a. He started to pronounce judgment on the surrounding nations: the Philistines, Moab, the Ammonites, Egypt, Assyria.
    - b. Then he turns the guns on Judah
  - vii. In the 18th year, Hilkiah the high priest found the book of Deut in the temple.
    - a. He gave it to Shaphan who took it an dread it to Josiah.
    - b. When Josiah heard it, he was crushed because he realized that the things that the Lord had forbidden in Deut were the things that the
