

- L. If any person asks questions of a controversial or theological nature, the Ushers should refer that person to the Pastor and let the Pastor answer the questions.

V. The Prayer Meeting

A. The Prayer Meeting in which the people stay together for prayer:

1. *Hymn
2. *Invocation
3. Hymn
4. Testimony Hymn
5. Prayer Time
 - a. The Pastor presents the prayer requests of which he has knowledge, and asks the congregation if there are any additional prayer requests.
 - b. The Pastor calls on someone in the congregation to lead in prayer to start the Prayer Time.
 - c. The Pastor closes the Prayer Time with prayer at the proper time.
6. Announcements
7. Offering
8. *Hymn
9. Bible Study
10. *Hymn
11. *Closing Prayer

NOTE: This isn't an order of service to be used in a church, but it is a list of the elements which may appear in this kind of Prayer Meeting. These elements have been inserted in the places where they usually occur. An asterisk means that the congregation is to stand.

B. The Prayer Meeting in which the people separate into groups for prayer:

1. *Hymn
2. *Invocation
3. Hymn
4. Testimony Hymn
